



Truckers' Web Guide **(for Eastern Canada/U.S. Border crossings)**

The Trucker's Web Guide was developed to assist trucking companies to gain access to information on the Internet relating to trucks moving goods across the eastern Canada/U.S. border. Given the significant number of rules, regulations, programs and processes related to these trans-border movements, it is often difficult to locate accurate and timely information. EBTC has designed this guide to be user friendly so a subject can be easily accessed on the Internet by clicking on the related link.
